**Procedural Order No. 2**

1. On September 26, 2012, the Commission issued its *Revised Rules of Standing and Funding* inviting applications for standing and funding from any person or group who has substantial and direct interest in the subject matter of the Inquiry or whose participation may be helpful to fulfill my mandate. The applications were due on October 17, 2012.
2. The Commission also advised that it would be holding hearings on the applications for standing and/or funding on October 26, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. at the Maple Room, Hampton Inn at 279 Highway 108 North, Elliot Lake, Ontario P5A 2S9.


