**AFFIDAVIT OF ALEXANDRE SENNETT**

I, ALEXANDRE SENNETT, of the City of Toronto, in the province of Ontario, MAKE OATH  
AND SAY:


1. I am the Applicant herein.
2. On May 14, 2013, I appeared, pursuant to a summons, at the Elliot Lake Commission of Inquiry regarding my involvement with the Elliott Lake Mall and a company known as Empire Roofing and Restoration Inc.
3. On June 11, 2013, after my testimony had been completed, I received a communication from this Commission of Inquiry. That letter very fairly offered me the option of applying for standing at the Inquiry in order to protect my interests.


4. Given the possible implications of my evidence, I wish to be granted standing at the Inquiry.
5. I also would like to be represented by counsel at the inquiry. The counsel I have selected to represent me is Jonathan Shime of the firm Cooper, Sandler, Shime & Bergman LLP.
6. Unfortunately, I do not have the financial means to pay Mr. Shime and his firm their legal expenses to represent me at the inquiry. Accordingly, I am also seeking funding to cover their legal fees and disbursements, including accommodation and travel expenses.
7. My current financial situation does not allow me to retain Mr. Shime and his firm privately. My taxable income in 2011 was \$24,098. Attached and marked as Exhibit 'A', to this my affidavit, is a copy of my Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada, which confirms my taxable income for that year. In 2012, my taxable income was \$20,771.00. Attached and marked as Exhibit 'B', to this my affidavit, is a copy of my Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada, which confirms my taxable income for that year. I anticipate that my income for 2013 will be approximately \$28,000.
8. I am currently the sole financial support for my family, including a four month old daughter. I do not own have any significant personal assets. I live with my wife and daughter in a rental unit that costs \$1330/month, or \$15,960/year. My monthly family expenses, including costs for my newborn daughter are approximately \$700/month or \$8400/year. I have telephone and computer expenses of \$150/month. These basic expenses total approximately \$26,160/year, which is more than my income for the last two years. In other words, I do not even make enough money to cover my family's basic expenses.
9. I do operate a business, now known as Bitflow Management Systems Inc.. However, that business is in significant debt and has been in trusteeship since September, 2012. As a condition of the trusteeship, I am required to pay \$1000/month to my creditors for a period of 60 months (on top of his other expenses, listed above). Attached and marked as Exhibit 'C', to this my affidavit, is a copy of a letter from BDO, dated September 9,

2012, confirming the trusteeship agreement and my required monthly contribution of \$1000/month.

10. If I am not granted funding for counsel to represent me, I will not be able to afford counsel on my own given my financial circumstances. Without counsel, I am extremely concerned that my interests would not be properly represented. I know that there may be a finding of misconduct against me and I want to ensure that everything that can be done at the Inquiry to protect me is done. In order to ensure that, I need both standing at the inquiry and funding for my counsel.
11. I make this affidavit in support of the herein application and for no improper purpose or motive.

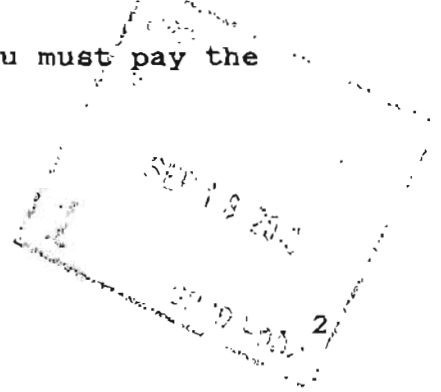
We have received your application for the 2012 Ontario energy and property tax credit. We will let you know if you are eligible for this credit.
