Dear Mr. Wallace:

Further to our telephone conversation, I am pleased to confirm that ELMAC, SAGE and our counsel group have come to terms. The result is that our counsel group will act for both organizations before the Commission.

I believe that the key points for the Commission to know are as follows:

1. SAGE continues to seek full standing; however, SAGE proposes that our counsel group will act for it.
2. Our counsel will represent both groups, provided that the requested funding is approved.
3. Our counsel group does not require an increased counsel budget in order to act for both groups, that is, we continue to seek funding for one senior counsel and one junior counsel daily plus applicable disbursements. SAGE does not require any other funding if funding is granted for counsel.

4. We do not anticipate any conflicts of interest arising between the two groups. However, if a conflict should arise, we will advise the Commission. In those circumstances, we will continue to represent ELMAC. SAGE would continue to have full standing at the Commission, but would either appoint new counsel or participate through Mr. Myles as originally contemplated by SAGE in its application for standing.

We hope for a speedy decision as we need to make arrangements for housing while in Elliot Lake if funding is approved.
