

A Historical Overview of Police Training Costs:

1962 – 1997	Police training was delivered to clients at no cost. The government of Ontario paid for all police training.
1997	Cost recovery was implemented at the recruit level. Each recruit was charged a fee of \$ 3000. to attend the 60-day Basic Constable Training Program.
1999	The cost of recruit training was increased to \$ 5000, a 60% increase over 1997 fees.
1999	Cost recovery was extended to all other police college courses. Based on comparisons to the post-secondary education sector, it was decided to recover 35% of the actual cost of post-recruit training. This increase was borne by the police services (municipalities), not individual officers.
January 2005	Recruit fees increased to \$ 7500.
January 2005	Fees for all post-recruit courses rise by 65% (from 35% to 100% cost recovery)
