

<i>COURSE NAME:</i>	Case Management of Complex Abuse Investigations
<i>COURSE CODE:</i>	CMA-
<i>DURATION:</i>	10 days
<i>CLASS SIZE:</i>	24 (8 police officers, 8 crown attorneys, 8 representatives from the Ministry of Community and Social Services)
<i>COURSE DESCRIPTION:</i>	This course takes an inter-disciplinary approach to the investigation and prosecution of multiple victim/multiple offender abuse investigations. Emphasis will be placed on major case management while defining the roles of Children's Aid Societies, police and Crown Attorneys. Candidates, upon successful completion of this course will be identified and serve as resource persons or case managers for complex abuse investigations.
<i>PREREQUISITES:</i>	Police officers at rank of Detective Sergeant or higher who are major crime case managers and have approval of the Course Co-ordinator.
<i>STANDARDS:</i>	Absence may not exceed one day.
<i>TOPICS:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • major case management • freedom of information/archive files • disclosure • substantive and procedural law • search and seizure issues • managing the victims • funding and budget requirements • selecting and training staff • constitutional issues
<i>DRESS:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • business attire or uniform
<i>EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • pens, pencils • current annotated Criminal Code
<i>SPECIAL NOTES:</i>	Course candidates will be required to submit a letter addressed to the attention of Crimes Against Persons Co-ordinator outlining their present responsibilities and why they require this course. Preference will be given to those candidates who are full-time major crime case managers.
