Dear Commissioner Glaude:

Re: Ontario Provincial Police Application for Standing

As you may know, I along with Diane Lahaie of Cornwall and Suzanne Costom of Montreal have been retained by the Ontario Provincial Police, Commissioner Gwen Boniface and commissioned officers of that police service in relation to the Cornwall Inquiry.

I hereby apply on behalf of those clients for standing in relation to Parts I and II of the Inquiry. It is my respectful view that our clients have an interest which is directly and substantially affected by the subject matter of Parts I and II as contemplated by the Inquiry's Rules of Practice and Procedure and that they ought to participate in accordance with subsection 5(1) of the *Public Inquiries Act*. Their interest arises in relation to the involvement of the OPP and its officers in the investigation into allegations of abuse of young people in the Cornwall area known as Project Truth, and in any systemic recommendations that may relate to issues of policing that will be under consideration. Further, their interest arises in relation to the processes, services and/or programs that would encourage community healing and reconciliation in the Cornwall area.

As you know separate counsel acts for the Ontario Provincial Police Association and non-commissioned officers. I expect that if standing is granted to his clients, as well as ours, we will resolve representation of officers who were non-commissioned at the time of the relevant events but are now commissioned officers.

We will of course be in attendance on November 7th, 2005 and thereafter when the standing applications will be considered.
