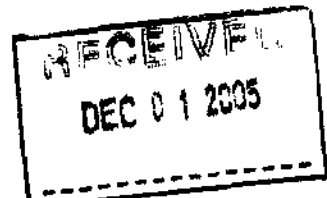

Cornwall Public Inquiry

On Behalf of the Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall and Bishop Eugène LaRocque

I, **Neal Ferguson**, of the City of Ottawa, in the Province of Ontario, make oath and say as follows:

1. I am the Senior Librarian at the Ottawa office of Borden Ladner Gervais LLP and as such have knowledge of the matters to which I hereinafter depose.
2. David Sherriff-Scott is a partner at Borden Ladner Gervais LLP and is the partner managing the file for the Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall ("the Diocese") as relates to its representation at the Cornwall Public Inquiry.
3. Following Mr. Sherriff-Scott's attendance at the Inquiry in early November on the subject of standing and funding, he instructed me to search out and find documents from the Walkerton Inquiry. In particular, he asked me to find document submitted by various parties to the Walkerton Inquiry in relation to their applications for funding. In this regard, I contacted the Ontario Archives. Mr. Sherriff-Scott advised me, and I believed, that the Walkerton documents were stored at the Ontario Archives. I also contacted the office of Freya Kristjanson, a partner at Borden Ladner Gervais LLP in Toronto who was one of the counsel to the Commission in the Walkerton Inquiry, to determine whether or not she had any remaining documents on the subject of funding.
4. As a result of my inquiries, I received a number of documents. I was advised by a representative of the Ontario Archives and I believe that they are currently undergoing construction in terms of their storage facilities and that the Walkerton Inquiry documents were not archived in accordance with their usual system. This is because of the volume of the documents and the transition into new premises.

5. I have attached as Exhibits to my Affidavit: the documents which I have been able to obtain from the sources to which I have referred. I have also attached two Charitable Information Returns taken from the Canada Revenue Agency's website which I am advised by Mr. Sherriff-Scott and believe were obtained by personnel in my office on his direction. Finally, I have attached some website information relating to the structure and membership of some organizations funded at Walkerton.

- (a) Exhibit A to my Affidavit is the application for standing and funding by the Association of Municipalities of Ontario;
- (b) Exhibit B to my Affidavit is the submission of the Professional Engineers and Architects of the Ontario Public Service (PEGO) for standing and funding dated August 29, 2000;
- (c) Exhibit C to my Affidavit is the submission for standing and funding on behalf of Walkerton Public Utilities Commission dated August 25, 2000;
- (d) Exhibit D to my Affidavit is the submission of the Ontario Farm Environmental Coalition, a website extract from the Ontario Government describing the lead members of the Ontario Farm Environmental Coalition, together with documents submitted to the Walkerton Inquiry by the Christian Farmers Federation of Ontario, the Ontario Farm Animal Council; a website extract from the last organization dealing with its membership, and extracts from the website of the Dairy Farmers of Ontario;
- (e) Exhibit E to my Affidavit is a copy of a letter dated January 30, 2001 from the office of the Commissioner of the Walkerton Inquiry to the Sierra Legal Defence Fund, together with the application for standing and funding submitted by the Sierra Legal Defence Fund on behalf of the Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment, the Council of Canadians and the Great Lakes United (described by that application as the Sierra Legal Coalition);


- (f) Exhibit F to my Affidavit is a copy of the Year 2000 annual information return for the Sierra Legal Defence Fund Society;
