

IN THE MATTER OF an application for supplementary funding by the Coalition for Action.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING

1. The Coalition for Action was granted standing and funding on or about September 12, 2007.
2. The Commission has heard approximately 74 witnesses over a period of over 100 days of evidence. The Commission has also provided counsel with a database of documents.
3. Counsel for the Coalition for Action applied to have a researcher review the transcripts and documents in order that counsel can become familiar with all of the prior evidence. Counsel also wished to focus more attention on the upcoming witnesses and evidence.
4. It was believed that the use of a researcher will be a cost effective use of public funds.
5. Approval was granted by order of the Commissioner recommending funding for a paralegal.
6. The Coalition for Action wishes to have a member of the Coalition actively involved in the process of reviewing the documents. It is believed that an active Coalition member will be very familiar with the role of the different witnesses and parties, and will therefore be able to review the documents more quickly. It is also believed that an active Coalition member will be able to be in a better position to locate facts that are relevant to the Coalition from the transcripts of prior evidence as a Coalition member will be more familiar with the issues being raised by the Coalition
7. It is proposed that Carson Chisholm be approved as a researcher and that the existing order recommending funding for a paralegal be amended to provide that Carson Chisholm can be hired to review documents instead of a paralegal. Mr. Chisholm has completed his evidence at the hearing and he wishes to become more active in locating relevant information for counsel and providing instructions. It is believed that his experience and knowledge of the parties involved, and the interests and objectives of the Coalition, make him an ideal candidate to do research work and assist counsel.
