Thank you for your letter of April 25, 2014 to Mr. Carr-Harris and me.

You will appreciate that it would be inappropriate for Commission Counsel to take a position with respect to your proposed application at this time.

The Commissioner has issued Procedural Order No. 5, dated April 29, 2014, a copy of which is attached hereto and can also be found on the Commission's website. As you can see, the Order imposes timelines and notice requirements which must be adhered to if this Commission is to fulfil its mandate in a timely and effective manner.

We expect that your materials will contain evidence to support all of the arguments you intend to make. Please ensure that your evidence includes:

- (a) a copy of the information in the Ontario Court setting out the charges against your client, including the back which shows the endorsement made by the Court at each appearance;
- (b) an indication of whether your client has yet been asked to make an election as to the court which will try your client and whether that trial will be by a judge sitting alone or a judge sitting with a jury and what election, if any, he has made; and
- (c) if he has not yet made an election, an indication of whether he has yet decided how he will elect and what that decision is.

We look forward to receiving your application materials.
