

**Supplementary Ruling on Standing – City of Toronto**

1. On March 28, 2013, I received a motion for standing from the City of Toronto (the “City”) seeking standing for Part II of the Inquiry.
2. Members of the City’s Heavy Urban Search and Rescue (“HUSAR”) team were deployed to Elliot Lake following the collapse on June 23, 2012. Thirty-six members of the HUSAR team were on site from June 24, 2012 until June 27, 2012. The HUSAR team worked with the Elliot Lake Fire Chief and other agencies involved in determining and implementing the strategic plans that were used in the response.
3. For the purpose of the determination of the City’s Motion, I rely on my findings at pages 2 and 3 of my Ruling on Standing and Funding dated November 8, 2012.
4. I agree with the City’s submissions that it has a substantial and direct interest in the subject matter of the Inquiry. I am also of the view that its participation would further the conduct of the Inquiry.
5. In light of the above, I exercise my discretion under Rule 8 of the *Revised Rules of Standing and Funding* to accept the City’s Motion and grant it standing for Part II of the Inquiry.
