

Subsequent Information and Clarifications from Roundtable Participants

On February 22, 2008, at page 135 of the transcript, Mr. Robertson provided an estimate regarding how much he would be paid for a child homicide case. Mr. Robertson has subsequently advised us that for a two week case, including all preparation and preliminary hearings, a silk would be likely to receive something in the region of \$30,000 rather than \$40,000. However, the junior would also have to be paid and that would bring the total cost of counsel for one party to something in the region of \$40,000-\$45,000.
